Brief About Tour:

Himachal Pradesh is famous for its beautiful views as well as adventure activities, such as treks, paragliding, skiing and so much more. It is a popular holiday destination with people of all age groups, be it young friends, honeymooners, families, and adventurers. The entire State is punctuated with stone as well as wood temples. The shadowy valleys, rugged crags, glaciers and gigantic pines, roaring rivers, and exquisite flora and fauna compose the symphony that is forever Himachal. The State has a rich treasure of places of pilgrimage and of anthropological value. Himachal is also called the "Fruit and vegetable bowl of India". Manufacturing, agriculture, and allied activities together accounted for 55 percent of Himachal Pradesh's GDP in 2020-21. Himachal Pradesh is aptly called "Dev Bhoomi" as it has a large association with Hindu mythology. The state is the land of numerous pilgrimage centers and several Hindu temples are located in Himachal Pradesh. As per statistics, there are more than two thousand temples in the state. In 2015, the first Paragliding World Cup was hosted in Himachal. India's oldest voter, Shyam Saran Negi, hails from Kalpa in Himachal Pradesh. He is a retired schoolteacher who cast the first vote in the 1951 general elections, and has voted in every general election since then. Shimla, the state capital, is popular among tourists. The Kalka-Shimla Railway is a mountain railway which is a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Shimla is also a famous skiing attraction in India. Other popular hill stations include Manali, Kinnuar, Kasol, Parvati Valley, Chamba, Kullu, Kinnar Kailesh, and Kasauli.

DAY WISE ITINERARY:
Day 1: Arrive Jammu – Katra

Arrive at Jammu Airport / Rly Stn, transfer to Katra (40 km, 1.5 hrs.), Upon arrival, check in to Hotel, Overnight stay.

Note: Jammu is a cantonment area hence only the local taxi union has the authority to pick up the customer from the Jammu airport. We request you cooperate with our local associate for on arrival arrangements.

Day 2: Katra to Vaishno Devi –Katra

Morning proceed to Mata Vaishno Devi Darshan. You can hire Horse /Palki or start trekking for 13 KM for Mata Vaishnodevi Darshan. Enjoy get together with your travel companions. "Jai Mata Di". Evening back to Katra. Overnight stay.

Day 3: Katra to Dharmshala:

After breakfast, check out from the hotel and proceed to Dharmshala (238 km. / 6 .5 hrs). Upon arrival, check in to Hotel. Later visit McLeodganj (Dharamshala), magnificently set to the background of the Dhauladhar Mountains and the seat of his Holiness, the Dalai Lama, the leader of the Tibetans, since 1960. Evening visit, Bhagsu Nag Temple and Tibetan Monastery. Overnight stay.

Day 4: Dharamshala

After breakfast, visit Dal Lake, Church, Chamunda Devi, Jwala Ji Temple, Kangra Devi. Overnight stay.

Day 5: Dharamshala - Dalhousie

After breakfast, proceed to Dalhousie (110 kms / 4 hrs.). Upon arrival, Check into Hotel. Later visit Khajjiar, popularly known as "Mini Swiss" for its Snow Capped Mountains and Pine Trees. Evening return back to hotel. Overnight stay.

Day 6: Dalhousie – Amritsar

After early breakfast, proceed to Amritsar (220 km, 5.5 hrs.), visit Indo – Pak Wagah Border, and then check in to the Hotel. Evening visit Golden Temple. Overnight stay.

Day 7: Amritsar Drop

After breakfast, check out the hotel. Visit Golden Temple and Jalian Wala Bagh and drop to Amritsar Airport / Railway station drop for the onward journey.
