Brief about Package:

RAJASTHAN: Rajasthan which is also known as the "Land of Maharajas" is the largest state of India, covering an area of about 342,239 sq. km. It comprises 33 districts and its largest city is Jaipur, which is also its capital. Being located on the western side of the country, it shares its border with Pakistan to its northwest, and to the west, it shares its border with Sindh. To its north it has Punjab, Uttar Pradesh, and Haryana to the northeast; to its southeast, it has Madhya Pradesh and Gujarat to its southwest. The glory of the state is retained by its majestic palaces, forts, and monuments. The vibrant culture and rich heritage of this princely state draw innumerable tourists from across the globe. Rajasthan which is also known as the "Land of Maharajas" is the largest state of India, covering an area of about 342,239 sq. km. It comprises 33 districts and its largest city is Jaipur, which is also its capital.....The glory of the state is retained by its majestic palaces, forts, and monuments. The tourism industry in Rajasthan is growing effectively each year and is becoming one of the major income sources for the state government. Rajasthan is home to many attractions for domestic and foreign travelers, including the forts and palaces of Jaipur, the lakes of Udaipur, the temples of Rajsamand and Pali, the sand dunes of Jaisalmer and Bikaner, the Havelis of Mandawa and Fatehpur, the wildlife of Sawai Madhopur, the scenic beauty of Mount Abu, the tribes of Dungarpur and Banswara, and the cattle fair of Pushkar.

DAY WISE ITINERARY :

Day 1: Arrival at Delhi Railway Station / Airport – Drive to Jaipur

Arrive at New Delhi airport/railway station and proceed to the Pink City of Jaipur (265 km /5 hrs.). En-route visit the Amber Fort and enjoy an elephant ride. Upon arrival at Jaipur, transfer to the hotel. The evening is free to explore the attractive colorful market of Jaipur. Overnight stay.

Day 2: Jaipur - Ajmer - Pushkar

Post breakfast, visit City Palace, Albert Hall, Hawa Mahal, and Jantar Mantar. Later, proceed to Ajmer (135 km /3 hrs.). Visit the famous Dargah of Salim Chisti and then drive to Pushkar (11 km). Here, visit the only Brahma Temple in India and the Pushkar Lake. Overnight stay.

Day 3: Pushkar - Udaipur

In the morning drive to Udaipur (286 km/6 hrs.). It was the capital of the Sawai Dynasty. Upon arrival, check into the hotel. Evening enjoys at the hotel. Overnight stay.

Day 4: Udaipur:

Today after having a delicious breakfast at the hotel you can enjoy the local visit to the famous Jagdish temple which enshrines a black stone image of Lord Vishnu/ Jagannath - Lord of the universe, City Palace, and the Saheliyon ki bari Gardens of the Maidens, on the bank of Pichori Lake. Overnight stay.

Day 5: Udaipur - Mount Abu

Morning drive to Mount Abu (190 km/ 4.5 hrs.), the only hill station in Rajasthan at an altitude of 1,220 m, crowning at the highest peak of the Aravali hills. Upon arrival, check into the hotel. Later, visit the magnificent Dilwara Jain Temples built in the 11th century, Sunset point, and Nakki Lake. Overnight stay.

Day 6: Mount Abu - Jodhpur

After breakfast, depart to jodhpur (325 km/7 hrs.), the second largest city in Rajasthan. Visit Mehrangarh Fort, Umaid Bhawan Palace, and museum. Overnight stay.

Day 7: Jodhpur – Jaisalmer

In the morning drive towards Jaisalmer (285 km/7 hrs).Upon arrival, check-in hotel. The evening is at leisure. Overnight stay.

Day 8: Jaisalmer

In the morning visit Jaisalmer Fort, the only fort in India which has a population of thousands of people living within its walls. Later, visit the countless havelis spread across Jaisalmer which are reputed as the city's real showpieces. In the evening visit the sand dunes to witness a spectacular sunset over the dunes. Overnight stay.

Day 9: Jaisalmer - Bikaner

Early morning proceed to Bikaner (332 km/7 hrs.). Upon arrival, transfer to hotel. Later, visit the unusual Junagarh Fort. Unlike all the major forts of Rajasthan, which are on hilltops, the Junagarh fort was built on the desert plains itself. Lastly, visit the National Research Centre on Camel. Overnight stay.

Day 10: Bikaner – Delhi

In the morning drive to Delhi (475 km/9 hrs.), transfer to airport/railway station for your onward journey.

2. Elephant Rides at Amer Fort remain suspended during Navratra Festival every year due to heavy rush of devotees at the Shila Mata Temple. Elephant rides are available at Hathi Gaon during this period. Call us for further details.
3. Elephant rides at Amer in Jaipur are closed during Dhulandi.
4. All major monuments in Rajasthan are closed on Dhulandi festival.
5. Junagarh Fort in Bikaner remains closed on Dhulandi and Diwali.
6. Lalgarh Palace in Bikaner remains closed on all Sundays and Dhulandi and Diwali.
7. Camel breeding farm in Bikaner remains closed on 26th January and 15th August every year and on Diwali.
8. Ganga Golden Jubilee museum in Bikaner remains closed on last Tuesdays of the month and Dhulandi.
9. Fort and Jain Temples in Jaisalmer remain closed on Gangaur and on Dhulandi festival.
10. Govt museum in Jaisalmer remains closed on National Holidays and Dhulandi festival.
11. Govt museum in Jodhpur remains closed on National Holidays and Dhulandi festival.
12. Kiradu Temple in Barmer remains closed on National Holidays and Dhulandi festival.
13. Govt museum and Bagore ki Haveli folk dances and museum in Udaipur remain closed on National Holidays and Dhulandi festival.
14. Rani Ji ki Baori, Kipling Palace (Sukh Mahal) and 84 pillar cenotaph in Bundi remain closed on National Holidays and Dhulandi festival.
15. Govt museum and Gagron Fort in Jhalawar remain closed on National Holidays and Dhulandi festival.
16. Ranthambore Tiger Sanctuary, Sariska Tiger Sanctuary and Mukundra Tiger Park are closed every year from July 01st to September 30th.
