DAY 1 (22:00 Hrs): Hyderabad – Hospet

At 10:00 PM Depart for Hospet (410 Kms / 8 hrs.) Note: The Coach will depart from our Hyderabad – Lakdi-Ka-Pul Office.

Night Journey

DAY 2(07:00 Hrs): Hospet - Hampi – Hospet

Morning arrive Hospet and then transfer to the hotel. After fresh-up and Breakfast, proceed to Hampi local visits covering Virupaksha Swamy Temple, Mahanavami Dibba, and Narasimha Swamy Temple & VijayaVittala Temple Back to hotel.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

Night Stay: Hospet

DAY 3(07:00 Hrs): Hospet - Gokarna

After Breakfast, check out from hotel and depart for Gokarna (310 kms / 7 hrs). On arrival, transfer to the hotel. After fresh ups visit Shri Ganesh Temple & Mahabaleshwar Temple.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

Night Stay: Gokarna

DAY 4(08:00 Hrs): Gokarna - Murudeshwar - Kollur – Udupi

After breakfast checkout the hotel and depart for Udupi, enroute visit Murudeshwara (80 kms / 2½ hrs) and Kollur Mookambika Temples (60 Kms / 1½ hours). Later depart for Udupi (75 kms / 1½ hrs). On arrival at Udupi, transfer to a hotel. In the evening visit Sri Krishna Temple. Overnight stay. Note: If permissible time, we can cover Idagunji Ganesh Temple prior to visit Murudeshwara.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

Night Stay: Udupi

DAY 5(05:00 Hrs): Udupi – Sringeri – Dharmasthala – KukkesubramanyaMorning

5:00 hrs proceeds to Sringeri Temple (100 Kms / 3hrs). Later visit Horanadu - Annapurneshwari Temple (65 Kms / 2 hrs) and then proceed to Dharmasthala (100 Kms / 2.5hrs). After temple visits, proceed to KukkeSubramanya (55kms / 1.5 hrs). On arrival, transfer to a hotel.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

Night Stay: Kukkesubramanya

DAY 6(08:00 Hrs): Kukkesubramanya -Belur-Halibeedu– Hassan

Early Morning @7AM Temple Darshan, After breakfast, check out the hotel at about 9:00 AM. Later proceed to visit Belur Chennakesava Temple (100 kms / 2 ½ hrs).Then depart for Halebidu - Hoysaleshwara Temple (20 Kms / 0.5 hrs) Later depart for Hasan (35 Kms / 1 hrs) On arrival transfer to a hotel.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

Night Stay: Hassan

DAY 7(08:00 Hrs): Hassan - Lepakshi– Puttaparthi

After Breakfast proceed to Lepakshi (250 Kms / 5.5 hrs) - Visit Veerabhadra temple. Then proceed to Puttaparthi (70 Kms / 1.2 hrs). Evening visit Sai Ashram.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

Night Stay: Puttaparthi

DAY 8(08:00 Hrs): Puttaparthi - Mantralayam – Hyderabad

After Breakfast departure to Mantralayam (250 Kms / 5 hrs) -Visit Raghavendra Swamy temple. Later proceed to Hyderabad (220 Kms / 4 hrs). Late evening arrive back at Hyderabad.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch

PLACES COVERED



Udupi

Udupi is a town in the south-west of Karnataka and is notable for the Krishna Temple, lending its name to the popular Udupi cuisine. Udupi, also known as Rajata Peetha is a centre of pilgrimage, situated about 58 km north of Mangalore. Udupi is known for the Krishna Mutt and also native place of the Vaishnavite saint Shri Madhvacharya. Shri Madhvacharya handed over the puja of Krishna Mutt to his 8 disciples and of them

set up their Mathas around the Krishna Mutt. During the Paryaya festival, which is held every two years, the Mutt management is handed over to the next Matha.

Sringeri



Sringeri Sharada Peetham is a monastery established by Adi Shankara in 8th century BC. The matha is on the banks of the Tunga River in Chikmagalur, 105 kilometres from Mangalore, Karnataka. The origin of the matha is described in various traditional sources. Adi Shankara is said to have lived here for twelve out of thirty-two years. Vishwarupa, assuming the name of Suresvaracharya, was installed here as the successor of Shankaracharya. The history of the Sringeri matha since the period of Sri Bharathi Tirtha has been documented.

Horanadu



Horanadu is a holy city for Hindus, located in Chickmagalur district, Karnataka. The deity at the Annapoorneshwari Temple is Annapurneshwari and the main deity of the goddess was put in place by Adi Shankaracharya. Horanadu lies amidst beautiful Malnad at 330 KM from Bengaluru. Every visitor to the Annapoorna temple at Horanadu, irrespective of their religion is provided with a three-course vegetarian meal. Male visitors to the temple have to remove their shirts, covering their shoulders with a towel or a shawl, as a symbol of respect for god. The main deity of Annapoorna is made of gold and it is widely believed that a person who seeks the goddess' blessings would never have any scarcity for food in life.

Hassan



Hassan is situated 934 mts above sea level with fine weather similar to Bangalore. The town was founded in the 11th century, by Channa Krishnappa Naik and was called Hassan after the Goddess "Haasanamba". The place is called the temple-architectural capital of Karnataka. Hassan, the main city dates back to the 11th century, during the Hoysala dynasty, which lasted to the fourteenth century. The earlier kings of town were of the Jain faith, who built some finest temples here, dedicated to Shiva. While the Hoysalas were at the zenith of their power, much of southern India along with this place was under their influence.

Halebidu



Halebidu, located in Hassan, Karnataka was the regal capital of the Hoysala Empire in the 12th century. It is home to one of the best examples of Hoysala architecture temples. Halebidu literally means ruined city and this name is given to it because city was ruined two times by Bahmani Sultanate. Halebidu was the 12th

century capital of the Hoysalas and the famous Hoysaleswara temple was built during this time by Ketamala, the Hoysala ruler. The temple complex comprises two Hindu temples, the Hoysaleshwara and Kedareshwara temples.
